

1 3. The Interpleader Defendants in this case, and anyone acting directly or indirectly on
2 their behalf, are enjoined from instituting or maintaining any action against the
3 Interpleader Plaintiffs relative to the subject Policy proceeds.

4 4. The Interpleader Plaintiffs are dismissed from this action with prejudice.

5 I FURTHER ORDER the clerk of the court to enter judgment accordingly because there
6 is no just reason to delay entry of judgment in favor of the Interpleader Plaintiffs and against the
7 defendant estate. Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b).

8 I FURTHER ORDER that, by December 17, 2021, defendant David Flicek will file an
9 appropriate motion to distribute the Policy proceeds and explain what, if anything else, needs to
10 be done to resolve this case. The failure to do so may result in dismissal of this case.
