Order Dismissing and Closing Case

ECF No. 10

Plaintiff Demarene Coleman filed this civil-rights lawsuit to redress constitutional
violations that he claims he suffered while incarcerated at Lovelock Correctional Center, but she
now seeks to voluntarily dismiss it.¹ Federal Rule of Civil Procedure (FRCP) 41(a)(1) permits a party
to dismiss an action without a court order by filing “a notice of dismissal before the
opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for summary judgment.”² Because no
defensive pleading has been filed in this case, I grant the motion and dismiss this action without
prejudice under FRCP 41(a)(1).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion for voluntary dismissal [ECF No. 10] is GRANTED, and this case is dismissed without prejudice. The Clerk of Court is directed to ENTER JUDGMENT accordingly and CLOSE THIS CASE.
