Pending before the Court is a joint proposed discovery plan. Docket No. 9.<sup>1</sup> The discovery plan seeks an elongated discovery period by not calculating it from “the date the first defendant answered or otherwise appeared.” *See* Local Rule 26-1(b)(1). Accordingly, the discovery plan is DENIED. The parties must either file a discovery plan that conforms to the default schedule in the local rules or comply with the requirements for seeking special scheduling review. An amended discovery plan must be filed by September 23, 2022.
