Under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure	e 41(a)(1), a plaintiff may dismiss an action withou
a court order by filing "a notice of dismissal b	before the opposing party serves either an answer of
a motion for summary judgment." ³ I grant Di	xon's motion to voluntarily dismiss this action
because no responsive pleading has been filed	l. Thus, I dismiss this action without prejudice.
