11 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's motion to compel. Docket No. 27. It appears from
12 the record that the motion to compel was filed prematurely before the response deadline expired
13 and, moreover, Defendants represent that they have now responded to the interrogatories. *See*
14 Docket No. 29 at 2. Accordingly, the motion to compel is DENIED as moot.

15 Also pending before the Court is Plaintiff's motion for default judgment arising out of his
16 contention that Defendants failed to respond to the interrogatories. Docket No. 28. In light of the
17 above, the motion for default judgment is also DENIED.
