**Stipulation and Order to Extend the
United States' Deadline to Answer or
otherwise respond to Plaintiff's
Complaint [ECF No. 1]**

(First Request)

19 Plaintiffs, Eric Garza and Jose Garza, through counsel, and the United States of
20 America, on behalf of Federal Defendants, through counsel, hereby agree and stipulate to
21 extend the deadline to answer or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's Complaint by 30 days,
22 until **March 4, 2024**.¹ The parties enter into this stipulation based on the following:

- 23 1. Plaintiffs filed their Complaint on November 15, 2023 (ECF No. 1).
24 2. Plaintiff served the United States with a copy of the Summons and Petition
25 on December 4, 2023.
26 3. The current deadline for Federal Defendants to answer or otherwise respond
27 is February 2, 2024.

28 ¹ Thirty days from the current deadline, February 2, 2024, is March 3, 2024. March 3, 2024, falls on a Sunday. The first weekday 30 days from the deadline is March 4, 2024.
