More than the allotted time has passed, and Harris has not filed an application 17 to proceed in forma pauperis or paid the filing fee or contacted the court in any manner. 18 Accordingly, this action is dismissed without prejudice as improperly commenced. 19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of Court detach and file the petition 20 (ECF No. 1-1). 21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petition is DISMISSED without prejudice as set 22|forth in this order. 23

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to stay proceedings in 8th Judicial Court (ECF No. 3) is **DENIED** as moot. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a certificate of appealability will not issue.
