16	For the foregoing reasons:	
17	IT IS ORDERED that Brown's motion to dismiss this case [ECF No. 6] is granted. This	
18	case is dismissed in its entirety, without prejudice.	
19	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Brown's application to proceed in forma pauperis [ECF	
20	No. 1] is DENIED as moot.	
21	The Clerk of the Court is directed to enter judgment accordingly and to close this case.
