**Order Denying Motions**

ECF Nos. 10, 11

9           Last October, I dismissed and closed this case for lack of subject-matter  
10 jurisdiction on the recommendation of the magistrate judge.<sup>1</sup> That dismissal came after  
11 the plaintiffs failed to respond to this court's order directing them to show cause why this  
12 case should not be dismissed on that basis.<sup>2</sup> Plaintiff Antonio Wheeler has now filed in  
13 this closed case a motion "to extend [his] 2-year time frame" in six different lawsuits he  
14 has filed, to reopen this case, to grant him *in forma pauperis* status, and to give him free  
15 copies of all the filings in his cases.<sup>3</sup> Because this case is closed and Wheeler has not  
16 demonstrated any legal basis to reopen it and grant the additional relief he is requesting,

17           **IT IS ORDERED that Wheeler's motions [ECF No. 10, 11] are DENIED.**

18 Wheeler is advised that he may not file any further motions in this case except a properly
