On December 9, 2024, Magistrate Judge Youchah recommended that I dismiss plaintiff a Warren's complaint (ECF No. 3-1) with prejudice. ECF No. 8. Warren appealed to the Circuit, which dismissed the appeal for lack of jurisdiction. ECF Nos. 12, 13. I thereafter Warren until March 6 to file an objection to Judge Youchah's report and recommendation No. 14). Warren did not file an objection. Thus, I am not obligated to conduct a de novo of the report and recommendation. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (requiring district courts to a de novo determination of those portions of the report or specified proposed findings to objection is made"); *United States v. Reyna-Tapia*, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003) nc) ("the district judge must review the magistrate judge's findings and recommendations o if objection is made, but not otherwise" (emphasis in original)).

I THEREFORE ORDER that Magistrate Judge Youchah's report and recommendation (ECF No. 8) is accepted and plaintiff Allanna Warren's complaint (ECF No. 3-1) is DISMISSED with prejudice.
