**Order Accepting Report and
Recommendation and Dismissing Case
With Prejudice**

9 On December 9, 2024, Magistrate Judge Youchah recommended that I dismiss plaintiff
10 Allanna Warren’s complaint (ECF No. 3-1) with prejudice. ECF No. 8. Warren appealed to the
11 Ninth Circuit, which dismissed the appeal for lack of jurisdiction. ECF Nos. 12, 13. I thereafter
12 gave Warren until March 6 to file an objection to Judge Youchah’s report and recommendation
13 (ECF No. 14). Warren did not file an objection. Thus, I am not obligated to conduct a de novo
14 review of the report and recommendation. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (requiring district courts to
15 “make a de novo determination of those portions of the report or specified proposed findings to
16 which objection is made”); *United States v. Reyna-Tapia*, 328 F.3d 1114, 1121 (9th Cir. 2003)
17 (en banc) (“the district judge must review the magistrate judge’s findings and recommendations
18 de novo *if objection is made*, but not otherwise” (emphasis in original)).

19 I THEREFORE ORDER that Magistrate Judge Youchah’s report and recommendation
20 (ECF No. 8) is accepted and plaintiff Allanna Warren’s complaint (ECF No. 3-1) is DISMISSED
21 with prejudice.
