**ORDER FOR ALLOWANCE
 OF FEES UNDER THE EQUAL ACCESS
 TO JUSTICE ACT, 28 U.S.C. § 2412**

18 Based upon the parties' Stipulation for Allowance of Fees under the Equal Access to Justice
 19 Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation (ECF No. 25) is GRANTED. IT IS
 20 FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall be awarded attorney fees in the amount of **\$6,127.50**
 21 (six-thousand one-hundred twenty-seven dollars and fifty cents). Such award is made in full and
 22 final satisfaction (upon payment) of any and all claims under the EAJA for fees, expenses, and costs.

23 Any fees paid belong to Plaintiff and not Plaintiff's attorney and can be offset to satisfy any
 24 pre-existing debt that the litigant owes the United States, *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 560 U.S. 586 (2010). If
 25 Defendant can verify that Plaintiff does not owe a pre-existing debt to the government subject to the
 26 offset, Defendant will direct that the award be made payable to Plaintiff's attorney pursuant to the
 27 EAJA assignment duly signed by Plaintiff and counsel.
