11 Because an amended complaint supersedes the original complaint in its entirety, defendant Tata
12 Consultancy Services Limited's motion to dismiss or, in the alternative, motion to compel
13 arbitration [ECF No. 9] targeting the original pleading is deemed moot. *Ramirez v. Cnty. of San*
14 *Bernadino*, 806 F.3d 1002, 1009 (9th Cir. 2015). Further, because Tata has filed a motion to compel
15 arbitration (ECF No. 18), its motion to dismiss or, in the alternative, motion to compel
16 arbitration [ECF No. 11] is also denied as moot.
