(Docket #1). Plaintiff has not 12 paid the \$350.00 filing fee and has not submitted an Application to Proceed in Forma Pauperis as 13 required by 28 U.S.C. §1915(a)(1) and Local Rules LSR 1-1 and 1-2. The Local Rules further require 14 that the application and complaint be made on the forms provided by this Court. LSR 1-1, 1-2, 1-4, and 15 2-1. 16 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall send Plaintiff a blank 17 application form for an application to proceed in forma pauperis for incarcerated litigants and a blank 18 civil rights complaint form with instructions. The Clerk of the Court shall also return a copy of Plaintiff's submissions to him. 19 20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the action is **DISMISSED** without prejudice for Plaintiff's 21 commencement of a **new** action in which he either pays the \$350.00 filing fee in full or submits a 22 complete Application to Proceed in Forma Pauperis, accompanied by a properly executed financial 23 certificate and a copy of his inmate trust account statement, and a complaint on the proper forms. The

Clerk of the Court shall enter judgment accordingly. Howard & Mikiller
