The Clerk of the Court shall also return a copy of Plaintiffs' submission to them.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the action is **DISMISSED** without prejudice for Plaintiffs' commencement of a <u>new</u> action in which they either pays the \$350.00 filing fee in
