## ORDER

Petitioner has submitted a Petition for Writ of Mandamus Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3771. He did not submit an application to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u>, nor did he pay the filing fee of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00). 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a).

Petitioner raised the same claim in an earlier petition, <u>Stoner v. Nevada Attorney General, et al</u>, Case No. 3:09-cv-00045-LRH-(VPC). The Court denied that earlier petition. The Court dismisses this action because Petitioner repeats previously litigated claims. <u>Cato v. United States</u>, 70 F.3d 1103, 1105 n.2 (9th Cir. 2005) (citations omitted).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court file the Petition for Writ of Mandamus.
