15	States District Judge. The action was referred to the undersigned Magistrate Judge pursuant
16	to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and the Local Rules of Practice, LR IB 1-4.
17	BACKGROUND
18	On July 8, 2009, Plaintiff filed her Application to Proceed <i>In Forma Pauperis</i> and Civil
19	Rights Complaint (Doc. #1). On September 16, 2009, the court sent Plaintiff its Order
20	(Doc. #2) which was returned, with the notation "RTS-Closed" (Doc. #3).
21	LSR 2-2 provides that "The plaintiff shall immediately file with the court written
22	notification of any change of address. The notification must include proof of service upon each
23	opposing party or the party's attorney. Failure to comply with this rule may result in dismissal
24	of the action with prejudice."
25	Without such notification the court can process this case and it becomes unmanageable.

1	Because of this circumstance and the Plaintiff's failure to comply with LSR 2-2, it is
2	recommended that the District Court enter an order dismissing this action with prejudice.
3	<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>
4	IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that the District Court enter an Order dismissing
5	this action with prejudice.
6	The parties should be aware of the following:
7	1. That they may file, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Rule IB 3-2 of the
