ORDER

In this capital habeas corpus action, on February 4, 2019, the Court ruled on the respondents' motion to dismiss (ECF No. 161) and dismissed certain of the claims of the petitioner, Fernando Navarro Hernandez. See Order entered February 4, 2019 (ECF No. 184). On March 1, 2019, Hernandez filed a motion for reconsideration (ECF No. 186), seeking reconsideration of the February 4 order. After a 21-day extension of time (ECF No. 188), Respondents' response to the motion for reconsideration was due on April 5, 2019.

On April 5, 2019, Respondents filed a motion for extension of time (ECF No. 189), requesting a second extension of time for their response to the motion for reconsideration; Respondents request another 14 days, to April 19, 2019. Respondents' counsel states that the extension of time is necessary because of his responsibilities in other cases. Hernandez does not oppose the motion for extension of time. The Court finds that the motion for extension of time is made in good faith and not solely for the

1 purposed of delay, and there is good cause for the extension of time. The Court will  
2 grant the extension of time that Respondents' request.
