Goldstrike seeks to extend the deadline by four days, from Monday, May 21, 2018, to Friday, May 25, 2018. Although the overall briefing schedule for the Renewed Motion was revised once before in order to accommodate the delivery of deposition transcripts (see Order Granting ECF No. 279 Joint and Stipulated Motion to Revise Briefing Schedule for Goldstrike's Motion to Dismiss [Doc. 280]), this is the first request to extend the deadline on Goldstrike's reply.<sup>1</sup>

The four-day extension on Goldstrike's reply is requested for two reasons.
