petitioner fails to include such a claim in his petition, he may be forever barred from seeking federal habeas relief upon that claim. See 28 U.S.C. §2254(b) (successive petitions).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk **SHALL FILE** the petition (Docket #1-1). **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that petitioner's motion for procedural orders (Docket #1-2) is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner's motion to appoint Richard F. Cornell as his counsel in this action (Docket #1-3) is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall SEND a copy of this order to the CJA Coordinator.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk shall ELECTRONICALLY SERVE the petition (Docket #1-1) and all attachments upon the respondents.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondents shall have forty-five (45) days from entry of this order within which to answer, or otherwise respond to, the petition. In their answer or other response, respondents shall address all claims presented in the petition. Respondents shall raise all potential affirmative defenses in the initial responsive pleading, including lack of exhaustion and procedural default. Successive motions to dismiss will not be entertained. If an answer is filed, respondents shall comply with the requirements of Rule 5 of the Rules Governing Proceedings in the United States District Courts under 28 U.S.C. §2254. If an answer is filed, petitioner shall have forty-five (45) days from the date of service of the answer to file a reply.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, henceforth, petitioner shall proceed through his counsel and shall not file documents in pro per unless otherwise ordered by this Court. Petitioner's counsel shall serve upon the Attorney General of the State of Nevada a copy of every pleading, motion, or other document he submits for consideration by the Court. Counsel shall include with the original paper submitted for filing a certificate stating the date that a true and correct copy of the document was mailed to the Attorney General. The Court may disregard any paper that does not include a
