15	Plaintiff has complied with this court's order of September 10, 2010 (Doc. #3), and has	
16	filed the Affidavit requested by the court (Doc. #4).	
17	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis	
18	(Doc. #1) is GRANTED . The Clerk of the Court shall file the Complaint. The movant herein	
19	is permitted to maintain this action to conclusion without the necessity of prepayment of fees	
20	or costs or the giving of security therefor. This order granting in forma pauperis status shall	
21	not extend to the issuance of subpoenas at government expense.	
22	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall issue summons to	
23	Defendant(s) herein and deliver same to the U.S. Marshal for service. The Clerk shall send	
24	Plaintiff sufficient copies of the complaint and service of process forms (USM-285) for each	
25	Defendant. Plaintiff shall have twenty (20) days in which to furnish the U.S. Marshal the	
26	required forms USM-285. Within twenty (20) days after receiving from the U.S. Marshal a	
27	copy of the USM-285 form showing whether service has been accomplished, Plaintiff must	
28	file a notice with the court identifying which Defendants were served and which were not	

served, if any. If Plaintiff wishes to have service again attempted on any unserved Defendant, then a motion must be filed with the court identifying the unserved Defendant(s) and specifying a more detailed name and/or address for said Defendant, or whether some other manner of service should be attempted. Plaintiff is reminded that, pursuant to Rule 4(m) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, service must be accomplished within one hundred twenty (120) days of the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that henceforth, Plaintiff shall serve upon Defendants or, if appearance has been entered by counsel, upon the attorney(s) a copy of every pleading, motion or other document submitted for consideration by the court. Plaintiff shall include with the original paper to be filed with the Clerk of the Court a certificate stating the date that a true and correct copy of the document was mailed to the Defendant(s) or counsel for a Defendant(s). The court may disregard any paper received by a District Judge or a Magistrate Judge which has not been filed with the Clerk of the Court, and any paper received by a District Judge, Magistrate Judge or Clerk of the Court which fails to include a certificate of service.
