invokes no federal statute or federal law. While the document to which defendants refer cites to federal case law, such citation does not convert this action into a federal case. Plaintiff has not alleged that his rights have been violated, merely that defendants acted negligently, causing him harm to pending litigation. He does not allege that he has been denied access to the courts or make other allegations of constitutional dimensions. "A suit arises under the law that creates the cause of action." American Well Works Co. v. Layne & Bowler Co. 241 U.S. 257, 260 (1916). In this instance, that is the law of the state of Nevada. The motion for remand shall be granted. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff's Motion for Remand (docket #3) is **GRANTED.** The matter shall be remanded to the Seventh Judicial District Court. The Clerk shall close this action.
