ORDER

Petitioner has paid the filing fee (#4). The court has reviewed his petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to Rule 4 of the Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases in the United States District Courts. The court will serve the petition upon the Attorney General of the State of Nevada for a response.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the clerk of the court shall file the motion for permission to file longer pages than normal writ of habeas corpus petition and the petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for permission to file longer pages than normal writ of habeas corpus petition is **GRANTED.**


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, as per prior agreement, that the clerk of court shall add Attorney General Catherine Cortez Masto

1 (listed under Cortez) as counsel for respondents and shall make
2 informal electronic service of this order and the petition upon
3 respondents by directing a notice of electronic filing to her
4 office.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondents shall have forty-
6 five (45) days from the date on which the petition was served to
7 answer or otherwise respond to the petition. If respondents file
8 and serve an answer, then they shall comply with Rule 5 of the
9 Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases in the United States District
10 Courts, and then petitioner shall have forty-five (45) days from
11 the date on which the answer is served to file a reply.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that henceforth, petitioner shall
13 serve upon respondents or, if appearance has been entered by
14 counsel, upon the attorney(s), a copy of every pleading, motion or
15 other document submitted for consideration by the court.
16 Petitioner shall include with the original paper submitted for
17 filing a certificate stating the date that a true and correct copy
18 of the document was mailed to the respondents or counsel for the
19 respondents. The court may disregard any paper received by a
20 district judge or magistrate judge that has not been filed with the
21 clerk, and any paper received by a district judge, magistrate
22 judge, or the clerk that fails to include a certificate of service.
