Hill an inmate at Northern Nevada Correctional Center. On February 17, 2011, the court 19 issued an order that, among other things, granted petitioner's motion for appointment of counsel and stated that a scheduling order would issue after petitioner's counsel appeared in the case. On March 17, 20 21 2011, counsel for petitioner entered a notice of appearance. Accordingly, the court sets a briefing 22 schedule on its January 27, 2011 order to show cause why the petition should not be dismissed as 23 untimely. After ruling on the order to show cause, the court will issue a scheduling order setting additional deadlines if necessary. 24 25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petitioner shall file a response to the court's January 26 27, 2011 order to show cause why his petition should not be dismissed as untimely within **thirty** days

from the date of service of this order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that respondents shall have **fifteen** days from the date of service of the petitioner's response to file a reply to the response.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that petitioner's motion to extend time regarding the order to show cause (docket #22) is **DENIED** as moot.
