1	forma pauperis and his motion for the appointment of counsel in a separate order in case number
2	3:11-cv-00354-HDM-RAM.
3	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk shall file the motion for leave to proceed
4	in forma pauperis (ECF No. 1), the motion for appointment of counsel (ECF No. 3), and the
