1	plaintiffs have sufficiently alleged a violation of Nevada's mandatory mediation requirement to
2	enjoin the pending trustee's sale. In their motion, plaintiffs allege that a notice of right to elect
3	mediation was never provided to them with the notice of default in violation of Nevada law. The
4	Nevada Supreme Court has recently held that strict compliance with the Nevada mediation statute,
5	including the notice provisions, is required before a property may be sold at a trustee's sale. See
6	Leyva v. National Default Servicing Company, 127 Nev. Adv. Op. 40. Therefore, this court shall
7	grant plaintiffs' motion and enjoin the pending trustee's sale.
8	
9	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order
10	(Doc. #1, Exhibit 6) is GRANTED. Defendants are ENJOINED from selling the underlying
11	property at the trustee's sale currently scheduled for February 23, 2012.
12	IT IS SO ORDERED.
