This action is a pro se civil rights complaint filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 by a state prisoner. Plaintiff has submitted a complaint and seeks leave to proceed in forma pauperis. (Dkt. no. 1.) In addition to filing the proper affidavit of inability to pay filing fees, a prisoner seeking to proceed in forma pauperis "shall submit a certified copy of the trust fund account statement (or institutional equivalent) for the prisoner for the 6month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint . . . obtained from the appropriate official of each prison at which the prisoner is or was confined." 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1), (2). Plaintiff in the instant action has failed to submit an in forma pauperis application that provides the necessary financial information and includes a financial certificate signed by an authorized prison or jail officer.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this action is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the filing of a new complaint in a new action, with a proper in forma pauperis application in compliance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court SHALL SEND plaintiff two copies of an *in forma pauperis* application form for a prisoner, one copy of the instructions for same, two copies of a blank 42 U.S.C. § 1983 prisoner civil rights form, and one copy of instructions for the same.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff may file a new complaint and *in forma* pauperis application in a new action, but he may not file further documents in this action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall enter judgment accordingly.
