On November 11, 2013, the Court ordered 22 Appellant to file an opening brief within fourteen days. He did not do so and has yet filed no 23 opening brief. Appellee has moved to dismiss for the first reason and has moved for summary 24 judgment for the second reason. Appellant has not timely responded to either motion. The Court 25 grants the motions. See L.R. Bank. P. 8070(a).
