1 2	(3) if there is no district in which an action may otherwise be brought as provided in this section, any judicial district in which any defendant is subject to the court's personal jurisdiction with respect to such action.	
3	28 U.S.C. § 1391(b)(1)-(3).	
4	The Court finds that Plaintiff may not file this civil rights action in the U.S. District Court	
5	for the District of Nevada. Based on the complaint, no defendants reside in Nevada and no	
6	events took place in Nevada. Instead, all of the defendants and all of the alleged events take	
7	place in Georgia.	
8	Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1406, "[t]he district court of a district in which is filed a case	
9	laying venue in the wrong division or district shall dismiss, or if it be in the interest of justice,	
10	transfer such case to any district or division in which it could have been brought." 28 U.S.C.	
11	§ 1406(a). The Court now orders that this case be transferred to the U.S. District Court for the	
12	Southern District of Georgia, Statesboro Division.	
13	II. CONCLUSION	
14	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that this case be transferred to the U.S.	
15	District Court for the Southern District of Georgia, Statesboro Division.	
16	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall close this case.
