14	I. DISCUSSION	
15	Plaintiff, who is a prisoner in the custody of the Nevada Department of Corrections	
16	("NDOC"), has filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis and has submitted an affidavit	
17	with exhibits. (ECF No. 1, 1-1). Plaintiff has not filed a complaint in this matter.	
18	Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 3, "[a] civil action is commenced by filing	
19	a complaint with the court." Fed. R. Civ. P. 3. As such, the Court grants Plaintiff thirty (30)	
20	days from the date of this order to submit a complaint to this Court. The Court will defer a	
21	decision on the application to proceed in forma pauperis until Plaintiff submits a proper	
22	initiating document for this case.	
23	II. CONCLUSION	
24	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that a decision on the application to	
25	proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 1) is deferred.	
26	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall submit a complaint to this Court within	
27	thirty (30) days of the date of this order.	
28	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall send to Plaintiff the	

1	approved form for filing a 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint and instructions for the same. The Clerk
2	of the Court shall also send Plaintiff a copy of his affidavit and exhibits (ECF No. 1-1).
3	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Plaintiff does not timely comply with this order,
4	dismissal of this action may result.
