24	procedural default. Successive motions to dismiss will not be entertained. If an answer is filed,		
25	respondents shall comply with the requirements of Rule 5 of the Rules Governing Proceedings in		
26	the United States District Courts under 28 U.S.C. §2254. If an answer is filed, petitioner shall have		;
27	forty-five (45) days from the date of service of the answer to file a reply.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any state court record exhibits filed by respondents shall be filed with a separate index of exhibits identifying the exhibits by number or letter. The hard copy of all state court record exhibits shall be forwarded, for this case, to the staff attorneys in the **Reno** Division of the Clerk of Court. The hard copy of all exhibits submitted to the Court shall be tabbed and shall be bound along the top edge of the pages.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, henceforth, petitioner shall serve upon the Attorney General of the State of Nevada a copy of every pleading, motion, or other document he submits for consideration by the Court.
