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13	I. DISCUSSION	
14	On October 7, 2014, this Court entered an order giving Plaintiff the option to seek	
15	voluntary dismissal of this case, without prejudice, to finish the grievance process and/or await	
16	extradition to California. (ECF No. 10 at 2). On October 14, 2014, Plaintiff filed a motion with	
17	the Court indicating that he wishes to voluntarily dismiss this case. (ECF No. 11 at 1). Plaintiff	
18	requests a copy of his original complaint, exhibits, and an application to proceed in forma	
19	pauperis. (Id.). The Court grants Plaintiff's motion to voluntarily dismiss this case.	
20	II. CONCLUSION	
21	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that the application to proceed in forma	
22	<i>pauperis</i> (ECF No. 1) is denied as moot.	
23	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for appointment of counsel (ECF No. 5) is	
24	denied as moot.	
25	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for voluntary dismissal (ECF No. 11) is	
26	granted. This case is dismissed in its entirety, without prejudice, pursuant to Plaintiff's	
27	voluntary dismissal of the case.	
28	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Cle	rk of the Court shall send Plaintiff a copy of his
	complaint (ECF No. 1-1).	
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1	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall send Plaintiff the approved	
2	form application to proceed in forma pauperis by a prisoner, as well as the document entitled	
3	information and instructions for filing an in forma pauperis application.	
4	The Clerk of the Court shall enter judgment accordingly.
