13	I. DISCUSSION	
14	Plaintiff, who is a prisoner in the custody of the Nevada Department of Corrections	
15	("NDOC"), has initiated a civil right action by filing a motion for emergency injunction (ECF No.	
16	1-1, a motion for temporary restraining Order (ECF No. 1-2), a motion for emergency medical	
17	treatment (ECF No. 1-3) and a lengthy motion for order to show cause (ECF No. 1-4). Plaintiff,	
18	however, has not filed a complaint in this matter. Plaintiff has also neither paid the full filing fee	
19	for this matter nor filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis.	
20	Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 3, "[a] civil action is commenced by filing	
21	a complaint with the court." Fed. R. Civ. P. 3. Accordingly, the Court grants Plaintiff thirty (30)	
22	days from the date of this order to submit a civil rights complaint to this Court.	
23	Additionally, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2) and Local Rule LSR 1-2, Plaintiff must	
24	complete an application to proceed in forma pauperis and attach both an inmate account	
25	statement for the past six months and a properly executed financial certificate.	
26	The Court will retain Plaintiff's initiating documents which have been docketed as a civil	
27	rights matter (ECF No. 1-1 through 1-4), until Plaintiff has submitted his civil rights complaint	
28	and the matter of the payment of the filing fee is resolved. Plaintiff will be granted an	

1	opportunity to file an application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> , or in the alternative, pay the full
2	filing fee for this action. If Plaintiff chooses to file an application to proceed in forma pauperis,
3	he must file a fully complete application to proceed in forma pauperis.
4	II. CONCLUSION
5	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:
6	(1) The Clerk of the Court SHALL SEND Plaintiff the approved form for filing a
7	42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint and instructions for the same.
8	(2) The Clerk of the Court SHALL SEND Plaintiff the approved form application to
9	proceed in forma pauperis by a prisoner, as well as the document entitled information and
10	instructions for filing an in forma pauperis application.
11	(3) Within <b>thirty (30) days</b> from the date of this order, Plaintiff shall either: (a) file a fully
12	complete application to proceed in forma pauperis, on the correct form with complete financial
13	attachments in compliance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a); or (b) pay the full \$400 fee for filing a civil
14	action (which includes the \$350 filing fee and the \$50 administrative fee).
15	(4) Also within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, Plaintiff shall submit a civil
16	rights complaint to this Court.
17	(5) If Plaintiff does not timely comply with this order, dismissal of this action may result.
18	(6) The Clerk of the Court shall retain the initiating documents (ECF No. 1-1 through
19	1-4), but shall not file them at this time.
