ORDER

I. DISCUSSION

On July 13, 2017, the Court issued a screening order which permitted Count I to proceed and dismissed Count II with leave to amend. (ECF No. 17 at 8-9). The Court granted Plaintiff 30 days from the date of that order to file a second amended complaint curing the deficiencies of the amended complaint. (*Id.* at 9). The Court specifically stated that if Plaintiff chose not to file a second amended complaint, the action would proceed against Defendants Dr. Koehn, Carpenter, Jones, Aranas, Dr. Donte, and George on Count I only. (*Id.*) Plaintiff has not filed a second amended complaint. Pursuant to the screening order, this action shall proceed against Defendants Dr. Koehn, Carpenter, Jones, Aranas, Dr. Donte, and George on Count I only.

II. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to the Court's screening order (ECF No. 17), this action shall proceed against Defendants Dr. Koehn, Carpenter, Jones, Aranas, Dr. Donte, and George on Count I only.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that given the nature of the claim(s) that the Court has permitted to proceed, this action is **STAYED** for ninety (90) days to allow Plaintiff and Defendant(s) an opportunity to settle their dispute before the \$350.00 filing fee is paid, an

1 answer is filed, or the discovery process begins. During this ninety-day stay period, no other
2 pleadings or papers shall be filed in this case, and the parties shall not engage in any
3 discovery. The Court will refer this case to the Court's Inmate Early Mediation Program, and
4 the Court will enter a subsequent order. Regardless, on or before ninety (90) days from the
5 date this order is entered, the Office of the Attorney General shall file the report form attached
6 to this order regarding the results of the 90-day stay, even if a stipulation for dismissal is
7 entered prior to the end of the 90-day stay. If the parties proceed with this action, the Court
8 will then issue an order setting a date for Defendants to file an answer or other response.
9 Following the filing of an answer, the Court will issue a scheduling order setting discovery and
10 dispositive motion deadlines.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that "settlement" may or may not include payment of
12 money damages. It also may or may not include an agreement to resolve Plaintiff's issues
13 differently. A compromise agreement is one in which neither party is completely satisfied with
14 the result, but both have given something up and both have obtained something in return.


15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the case does not settle, Plaintiff will be required to
16 pay the full \$350.00 filing fee. This fee cannot be waived. If Plaintiff is allowed to proceed *in*
17 *forma pauperis*, the fee will be paid in installments from his prison trust account. 28 U.S.C.
18 § 1915(b). If Plaintiff is not allowed to proceed *in forma pauperis*, the \$350.00 will be due
19 immediately.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if any party seeks to have this case excluded from the
21 inmate mediation program, that party shall file a "motion to exclude case from mediation" on
22 or before twenty-one (21) days from the date of this order. The responding party shall have
23 seven (7) days to file a response. No reply shall be filed. Thereafter, the Court will issue an
24 order, set the matter for hearing, or both.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall electronically **SERVE** a
26 copy of this order, the original screening order (ECF No. 17) and a copy of Plaintiff's amended
27 complaint (ECF No. 18) on the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Nevada, attention
28 Barbara Fell.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Attorney General's Office shall advise the Court
2 within twenty-one (21) days of the date of the entry of this order whether it will enter a limited
3 notice of appearance on behalf of Defendants for the purpose of settlement. No defenses or
4 objections, including lack of service, shall be waived as a result of the filing of the limited notice
5 of appearance.
