ORDER

Before the Court is the Reports and Recommendations of U.S. Magistrate Judge (ECF No. 65¹) entered on April 21, 2017, recommending that the Court that certain claims be dismissed. On May 5, 2017, Plaintiff filed his Objections to Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation (ECF No. 66).


The Court has conducted its *de novo* review in this case, has fully considered the objections of the Plaintiff, the pleadings and memoranda of the parties and other relevant matters of record pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule IB 3-2.
