13	I. DISCUSSION
14	On November 9, 2015, Plaintiff, a pro se prisoner, submitted a 42 U.S.C. § 1983 civil
15	rights complaint with a motion stating that he would pay the full filing fee of \$400 within 45
16	days. (ECF No. 1-1, 1-2). On January 8, 2016, Plaintiff paid the full \$400 filing fee. (ECF No.
17	4). On January 12, 2016, Plaintiff filed a motion to have the Court file his complaint because
18	the statute of limitations for his claims would expire in ten days. (ECF No. 5).
19	The Court grants Plaintiff's motion to file his complaint in light of receiving the full filing
20	fee of \$400. The Court will enter a screening order on this complaint in a separate order in
21	the future. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(a).
22	II. CONCLUSION
23	For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that the motion to file the complaint (ECF
24	No. 5) is granted. The Clerk of the Court is directed to file Plaintiff's complaint (ECF No. 1-1).
