13	supplemented pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 10(e)(2)(b). The purpose
14	of the supplement is to correct a material misstatement in two orders to assist the court
15	of appeals in its review of the record and final decision. See Davis v. United States, 667
16	F.2d 822, 824 (9th Cir. 1982) ("The district court may act to assist the court of appeals in
17	the exercise of its jurisdiction.") (internal citation omitted).
18	The Court's two prior orders (ECF Nos. 6, 36) incorrectly assumed that Plaintiff
19	Tarik Messaad had been convicted of the crime for which he was arrested when in fact
20	the charge was pending at the initiation of this case. After the first order was issued, both
21	parties submitted records which indicate that the charge was dismissed on October 11,
22	2016. (ECF No. 24 at 1; ECF No. 16-1 at 3.)
