## I. DISCUSSION

15 On March 6, 2017, this Court issued an order directing Plaintiff to file an updated  
16 address with the Court on or before Friday, March 24, 2017. (ECF No. 10 at 1). The Court  
17 stated that, if Plaintiff failed to file an updated address, the Court would dismiss the case with  
18 prejudice. (*Id.* at 2). Plaintiff has not filed an updated address.

19 On March 27, 2017, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss (ECF No. 12) and a motion  
20 for relief from the mediation scheduling order (ECF No. 13) in light of Plaintiff's failure to file  
21 an updated address. That same day, the Northern Nevada Correctional Center ("NNCC")  
22 returned the filings with a note stating, "inmate paroled 2/16/17, forwarding address:  
23 1015 N. Sierra St., Reno, NV 89503." (ECF No. 14, 14-1).

24 In light of receiving this address, the Court will grant Plaintiff an extension of time to file  
25 his updated address with the Court.<sup>1</sup> The Court grants Plaintiff until Friday, April 14, 2017, to  
26 file his updated address with this Court. If Plaintiff does not update the Court with his current

<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to Nevada Local Special Rule 2-2, “[t]he plaintiff must immediately file with the court written notification of any change of address. The notification must include proof of service on each opposing party or the party’s attorney. Failure to comply with this rule may result in dismissal of the action with prejudice.” Nev. Loc. Special R. 2-2.

1 address on or before Friday, April 14, 2017, the Court will dismiss this action with prejudice.  
2 No further extensions will be granted.

3 The Court now vacates the Inmate Early Mediation Conference scheduled for May 2,  
4 2017. (ECF No. 11). If Plaintiff timely files his updated address with this Court, the Court will  
5 re-schedule the Inmate Early Mediation Conference. As such, the Court denies both  
6 Defendants' motion to dismiss (ECF No. 12) and motion for relief from mediation scheduling  
7 order (ECF No. 13) as moot.

8 **II. CONCLUSION**

9 For the foregoing reasons, **IT IS ORDERED** that Plaintiff shall file his updated address  
10 with the Court on or before **Friday, April 14, 2017**.

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, if Plaintiff fails to file his updated address on or before  
12 Friday, April 14, 2017, the Court will dismiss this case with prejudice.

13 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Court will send Plaintiff a one-time  
14 courtesy copy of this order to Plaintiff at 1015 N. Sierra St., Reno, NV 89503. However, the  
15 Clerk of the Court will not change Plaintiff's address on record until Plaintiff files an updated  
16 address with the Court.

17 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Inmate Early Mediation Conference scheduled for  
18 May 2, 2017 (ECF No. 11) is vacated.

19 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the motion to dismiss (ECF No. 12) is denied as  
20 moot.

21 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the motion for relief from mediation scheduling order  
22 (ECF No. 13) is denied as moot.
