ORDER

1 Before the court is the Declaration of Albert L. Thuesen, III, in Support of Order for Sanctions
2 (ECF No. 118).

3 On July 9, 2018, this court entered an order (ECF No. 117) requiring Albert L. Thuesen, III, Esq.,
4 counsel for Defendants, Counterclaimants and Third Party Plaintiffs Edward Bollman and James Kerr
5 to supplement the Bollman-Kerr motion for cost sanctions, said sanctions to include an allowance for
6 corresponding attorney's fees. (ECF Nos. 104, 106.) While the court granted the Bollman-Kerr motion
7 to compel and granted sanctions as against Third Party Defendant Thomas Ripley, the court required
8 Attorney Thuesen to document his hourly fees which constituted the bulk of his clients' request for
9 sanctions. Mr. Thuesen has submitted a declaration verifying his fees and costs. (ECF No. 117.)

10 Good cause appearing, the court awards cost sanctions in favor of Bollman and Kerr and against
11 Third Party Defendant Thomas Ripley in the amount of \$6,307.44.
