13 **I. DISCUSSION**

14 According to the Nevada Department of Corrections ("NDOC") inmate database,
15 Plaintiff is no longer at the address listed with the Court and Plaintiff has not filed an
16 updated address with this Court. The Court notes that pursuant to Nevada Local Rule
17 of Practice IA 3-1, a "pro se party must immediately file with the court written notification
18 of any change of mailing address ... Failure to comply with this rule may result in the
19 dismissal of the action, entry of default judgment, or other sanctions as deemed
20 appropriate by the court." Nev. Loc. R. IA 3-1. This Court grants Plaintiff thirty (30)
21 days from the date of entry of this order to file his updated address with this Court. If
22 Plaintiff does not update the Court with his current address within thirty (30) days from
23 the date of entry of this order, the Court will dismiss this action without prejudice.

24 **II. CONCLUSION**

25 For the foregoing reasons, **IT IS ORDERED** that Plaintiff shall file his updated
26 address with the Court within **thirty (30) days** from the date of this order.

27 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, if Plaintiff fails to timely comply with this order,
28 the Court shall dismiss this case without prejudice.


