claims in state court — i.e. whether Turner has made in state court the claims that he

makes here in federal court. It appears that respondents have filed sufficient material from

the state-court record for the Court to resolve those issues. The exhaustion issues turn on well-settled legal principles.

However, the Court will, *sua sponte*, grant Turner an extension of time to respond to the motion to dismiss.

It is therefore ordered that petitioner's Motion for Appointment of Counsel (ECF No. 18) is denied.

It is further ordered that petitioner will have until and including September 22, 2017, to respond to respondents' motion to dismiss (ECF No. 10). In all other respects, the schedule for further proceedings set forth in the order entered April 4, 2017 (ECF No. 5) will remain in effect.
