3 The court recognizes that certain of these documents have been filed under seal, mainly
4 because they contain Plaintiff's sensitive medical/mental health information. Typically, inmates at
5 NDOC facilities are required to kite the warden at their housing facility to review medical/mental
6 health records in connection with litigation. Plaintiff is currently housed at CCDC, and not a
7 NDOC facility. The sensitive information is being sealed from the public's access, but Plaintiff
8 must have access to the materials to draft his reply brief. Therefore, the court is ordering that these
9 documents, including sealed documents, be sent directly to Plaintiff at CCDC.
