

1 The parties represent this Stipulation is based on a meet and confer conference wherein
2 the parties agreed that if either party filed a motion in limine in January, responses would be due
3 at the end of February. The parties represent this stipulation is made in good faith and not for the
4 purposes of delay. The parties have not previously applied for any extensions of time related to
5 the briefing schedule for motions in limine.

6 Accordingly, the parties request the Court order the deadline for Defendant to respond to
7 Plaintiff's First and Second Motions *in Limine* be extended to February 28, 2020.
