*Pro se* 28 U.S.C. § 2254 habeas Petitioner William Workman (“Workman or Petitioner”) filed a motion to amend his petition (ECF No. 18). Within the purported motion, he actually sets forth the claims he wishes to add. In the interests of judicial efficiency, Workman’s motion is granted. The Court considers the filing at ECF No. 18 to be his statement of additional claims. The petition at ECF No. 13, together with the statement of additional claims at ECF No. 18, will comprise his petition.

Workman has also filed a second motion for default (ECF No. 33). He apparently believes that Respondents have missed a deadline. However, Respondents have filed a motion to extend time to file a response to the petition until after the Court resolves Workman’s motion to amend. Workman’s motion for default is denied.

It is therefore ordered that that Petitioner’s motion to amend petition (ECF No. 18) is granted. The petition at ECF No. 13, together with the statement of additional claims at ECF No. 18, comprises the petition.

It is further ordered that Respondents’ motion for leave to file certain state court records under seal (ECF No. 28) is granted.
