| 15 | I. DISCUSSION |
| 16 | According to the Nevada Department of Corrections ("NDOC") inmate database, |
| 17 | Plaintiff is no longer at the address listed with the Court. The Court notes that pursuant |
| 18 | to Nevada Local Rule of Practice IA 3-1, a "pro se party must immediately file with the |
| 19 | court written notification of any change of mailing address, email address, telephone |
| 20 | number, or facsimile number. The notification must include proof of service on each |
| 21 | opposing party or the party's attorney. Failure to comply with this rule may result in the |
| 22 | dismissal of the action, entry of default judgment, or other sanctions as deemed |
| 23 | appropriate by the court." Nev. Loc. R. IA 3-1. This Court grants Plaintiff thirty (30) days |
| 24 | from the date of entry of this order to file his updated address with this Court. If Plaintiff |
| 25 | does not update the Court with his current address within thirty (30) days from the date |
| 26 | of entry of this order, the Court will dismiss this action without prejudice. |
| 27 | II. CONCLUSION |
| 28 | For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff shall file his updated |

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| 2 | IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if Plaintiff fails to timely comply with this order, |
