ORDER

I. DISCUSSION

On November 7, 2018, the Court issued a screening order dismissing some claims with leave to amend and permitting the excessive force claim in Count I to proceed against Defendant Scarlett. (ECF No. 6 at 6.) The Court granted Plaintiff 28 days from the date of that order to file an amended complaint. (*Id.*) The Court specifically stated that if Plaintiff chose not to file an amended complaint, the action would proceed only on the excessive force claim in Count I against Defendant Scarlett. (*Id.*) Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint. Therefore, pursuant to the screening order, this action shall proceed on the excessive force claim in Count I against Defendant Scarlett.

II. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to the Court's screening order (ECF No. 6), this action shall proceed on the excessive force claim in Count I against Defendant Scarlett.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that given the nature of the claim(s) that the Court has permitted to proceed, this action is STAYED for ninety (90) days to allow Plaintiff and

1 Defendant(s) an opportunity to settle their dispute before the \$350.00 filing fee is paid, an
2 answer is filed, or the discovery process begins. During this ninety-day stay period, no
3 other pleadings or papers shall be filed in this case, and the parties shall not engage in
4 any discovery. The Court will refer this case to the Court's Inmate Early Mediation
5 Program, and the Court will enter a subsequent order. Regardless, on or before ninety
6 (90) days from the date this order is entered, the Office of the Attorney General shall file
7 the report form attached to this order regarding the results of the 90-day stay, even if a
8 stipulation for dismissal is entered prior to the end of the 90-day stay. If the parties
9 proceed with this action, the Court will then issue an order setting a date for Defendants
10 to file an answer or other response. Following the filing of an answer, the Court will issue
11 a scheduling order setting discovery and dispositive motion deadlines.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that "settlement" may or may not include payment of
13 money damages. It also may or may not include an agreement to resolve Plaintiff's issues
14 differently. A compromise agreement is one in which neither party is completely satisfied
15 with the result, but both have given something up and both have obtained something in
16 return.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if any party seeks to have this case excluded from
18 the inmate mediation program, that party shall file a "motion to exclude case from
19 mediation" on or before twenty-one (21) days from the date of this order. The responding
20 party shall have seven (7) days to file a response. No reply shall be filed. Thereafter, the
21 Court will issue an order, set the matter for hearing, or both.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall electronically SERVE
23 a copy of this order, the original screening order (ECF No. 6) and a copy of Plaintiff's
24 complaint (ECF No. 7) on the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Nevada, by
25 adding the Attorney General of the State of Nevada to the docket sheet. This does not
26 indicate acceptance of service.

27 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Attorney General's Office shall advise the
28 Court within twenty-one (21) days of the date of the entry of this order whether it will enter

1 a limited notice of appearance on behalf of Defendants for the purpose of settlement. No
2 defenses or objections, including lack of service, shall be waived as a result of the filing
3 of the limited notice of appearance.
