Case Management Conference should be vacated for the following reasons:

RECITALS

- 1. This case, which alleges that the prescription drug Abilify® caused Plaintiffs to engage in compulsive behaviors such as pathological gambling, was removed to this Court on the basis of diversity jurisdiction. ECF 1.
- On April 4, 2018, the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (the "JPML") 2. ordered that this case be transferred conditionally to the Abilify® multidistrict litigation (the MDL") in the Northern District of Florida, where more than 1,000 involving similar claims that Abilify caused pathological gambling are pending. Case MDL No. 2734, ECF No. 139.
- 3. Plaintiffs have filed a motion to remand this case, ECF No. 8, and have opposed the motion to vacate, Case MDL No. 2734, ECF No. 148.
- Defendants have moved to stay all proceedings in this case, including decision on 4. the remand motion, pending the JPML's decision on the transfer of this case to the MDL. ECF No. 23. Briefing on the Motion to Stay is under way.
- On April 23, 2018, this Court entered an Order Setting Case Management 5. Conference pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 16 and Local Rule ("LR") 16-2 (the "Case Management Order"), setting a case management conference for Thursday, May 17, 2018 and ordering the filing of a joint case management report not less than seven (7) court dates before the case management conference.
- Depending on how the Court rules on the pending options, this case will be either 6. transferred to the MDL or remanded to state court. As such, there is no benefit to proceeding with the case management conference and its corresponding deadlines. Vacating the Case Management Order is thus warranted.
- Accordingly, the parties stipulate and agree that vacating the Case Management 7. Order until a decision is entered on the Motion to Vacate or the Motion to Remand serves the best interests of judicial economy, minimizes litigation expense, and otherwise preserves the resources of the parties.
