

the event that this action is dismissed, the full filing fee must still be paid pursuant to 28
U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2).

2. The movant herein is permitted to maintain this action to conclusion without
the necessity of prepayment of any additional fees or costs or the giving of security
therefor. This order granting leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* shall not extend to the
issuance and/or service of subpoenas at government expense.

3. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2), the Nevada Department of Corrections 7 shall pay to the Clerk of the United States District Court, District of Nevada, 20% of the 8 preceding month's deposits to Plaintiff's account (Gregory Hamilton, # 21147), in the 9 months that the account exceeds \$10.00, until the full \$350.00 filing fee has been paid 10 for this action. The Clerk of the Court shall **SEND** a copy of this order to the Finance 11 Division of the Clerk's Office. The Clerk of the Court shall also **SEND** a copy of this order 12 to the attention of the Chief of Inmate Services for the Nevada Department of Corrections, 13 P.O. Box 7011, Carson City, NV 89702. 14

4. The Clerk of the Court shall electronically SERVE a copy of this order and
a copy of Plaintiff's complaint (ECF No. 1-1) on the Office of the Attorney General of the
State of Nevada by adding the Attorney General of the State of Nevada to the docket
sheet. This does not indicate acceptance of service.

19 5. Service must be perfected within ninety (90) days from the date of this order
20 pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m).

6. Subject to the findings of the screening order (ECF No. 3), within twenty-21 one (21) days of the date of entry of this order, the Attorney General's Office shall file a 22 notice advising the Court and Plaintiff of: (a) the names of the defendants for whom it 23 24 accepts service; (b) the names of the defendants for whom it does not accept service, and (c) the names of the defendants for whom it is filing the last-known-address 25 information under seal. As to any of the named defendants for whom the Attorney 26 General's Office cannot accept service, the Office shall file, under seal, but shall not serve 27 the inmate Plaintiff the last known address(es) of those defendant(s) for whom it has such 28

information. If the last known address of the defendant(s) is a post office box, the Attorney
 General's Office shall attempt to obtain and provide the last known physical address(es).

7. If service cannot be accepted for any of the named defendant(s), Plaintiff
shall file a motion identifying the unserved defendant(s), requesting issuance of a
summons, and specifying a full name and address for the defendant(s). For the
defendant(s) as to which the Attorney General has not provided last-known-address
information, Plaintiff shall provide the full name and address for the defendant(s).

8 8. If the Attorney General accepts service of process for any named
9 defendant(s), such defendant(s) shall file and serve an answer or other response to the
10 complaint within sixty (60) days from the date of this order.

9. Henceforth, Plaintiff shall serve upon defendant(s) or, if an appearance has 11 been entered by counsel, upon their attorney(s), a copy of every pleading, motion or other 12 document submitted for consideration by the Court. Plaintiff shall include with the original 13 document submitted for filing a certificate stating the date that a true and correct copy of 14 the document was mailed or electronically filed to the defendants or counsel for the 15 defendants. If counsel has entered a notice of appearance, Plaintiff shall direct service 16 to the individual attorney named in the notice of appearance, at the physical or electronic 17 address stated therein. The Court may disregard any document received by a district 18 judge or magistrate judge which has not been filed with the Clerk, and any document 19 received by a district judge, magistrate judge, or the Clerk which fails to include a 20 certificate showing proper service. 21
