9	I. DISCUSSION		
10	On November 16, 2020, Plaintiff, an inmate in the custody of the Nevada		
11	Department of Corrections ("NDOC"), submitted a civil rights complaint under 42 U.S.C.		
12	§ 1983 and filed an application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> . (ECF Nos. 1-1, 1). Plaintiff's		
13	application to proceed in forma pauperis is incomplete.		
14	Under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2) and Local Rule LSR 1-2, an inmate seeking to begin		
15	a civil action in this Court may apply to proceed in forma pauperis in order to file the civil		
16	action without prepaying the full \$400 filing fee. To apply for <i>in forma pauperis</i> status, the		
17	inmate must submit all three of the following documents to the Court:		
18	(1) a completed Application to Proceed in Forma Pauperis for Inmate, this		
19	Court's approved form (i.e. pages 1 through 3 with the inmate's two signatures on		
20	page 3),		
21	(2) a Financial Certificate properly signed by both the inmate and a prison or jail		
22	official (i.e. page 4 of this Court's approved form), and		
23	(3) a copy of the inmate's prison or jail trust fund account statement for the		
24	previous six-month period.		
25	Plaintiff has not submitted an application on this Court's approved form with a		
26	Financial Certificate and an inmate account statement for the previous six-month period.		
27	Accordingly, the Court denies Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF		
28	No. 1) without prejudice because the application is incomplete. The Court will grant

Plaintiff a **one-time extension** to file a fully complete application to proceed in forma 2 *pauperis* containing all three of the required documents. Plaintiff will file a fully complete 3 application to proceed in forma pauperis on or before January 19, 2021. Absent unusual 4 circumstances, the Court will not grant any further extensions of time.

If Plaintiff does not file a fully complete application to proceed in forma pauperis 6 with all three required documents on or before January 19, 2021, this case will be subject 7 to dismissal without prejudice for Plaintiff to file a new case with the Court when Plaintiff 8 is able to acquire all three of the documents needed to file a fully complete application to 9 proceed *in forma pauperis* or pays the full \$400 filing fee.

10 A dismissal without prejudice means Plaintiff does not give up the right to refile the 11 case with the Court, under a new case number, when Plaintiff has all three documents 12 needed to submit with the application to proceed in forma pauperis. Alternatively, Plaintiff 13 may choose not to file an application to proceed in forma pauperis and instead pay the 14 full filing fee of \$400 on or before January 19, 2021 to proceed with this case.

15 The Court will retain Plaintiff's civil rights complaint (ECF No. 1-1), but the Court 16 will not file the complaint unless and until Plaintiff timely files a fully complete application 17 to proceed in forma pauperis with all three documents or pays the full \$400 filing fee.

II.

CONCLUSION

19 For the foregoing reasons, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff's application to proceed 20 in forma pauperis (ECF No. 1) is denied without prejudice to file a new fully complete 21 application to proceed in forma pauperis with all three documents.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court will send Plaintiff the approved form application to proceed in forma pauperis by an inmate, as well as the 23 24 document entitled information and instructions for filing an *in forma pauperis* application.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before **January 19, 2021**, Plaintiff will either 26 pay the full \$400 filing fee for a civil action (which includes the \$350 filing fee and the \$50 27 administrative fee) or file with the Court:

(1) a completed Application to Proceed in Forma Pauperis for Inmate on this

1 2	Court's approved form (i.e. pages 1 through 3 of the form with the inmate's two signatures on page 3),		
3	(2) a <u>Financial Certificate</u> properly signed by both the inmate and a prison or jail		
4	official (i.e. page 4 of this Court's approved form), and		
5	(3) a copy of the inmate's prison or jail trust fund account statement for the		
6	previous six-month period.		
7	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if Plaintiff does not file a fully complete		
8	application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> with all three documents or pay the full \$400 filing fee for a givil action on or before Japuary 10, 2021 , this case will be subject to		
9	filing fee for a civil action on or before January 19, 2021 , this case will be subject to dismissal <u>without prejudice</u> for Plaintiff to refile the case with the Court, under a new case		
10 11	number, when Plaintiff has all three documents needed to file a complete application to		
12	proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> or pays the the full \$400 filing fee.		
13	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court will retain the complaint		
14	(ECF No.1-1) but will not file it at this time.
