Plaintiff's request to proceed in forma pauperis is granted, but pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915, as amended, the filing fee must be paid as follows: the sum of \$20.00 is due no later than October 11, 2005. In addition, 20% of each preceding month's income credited to plaintiff's account to be remitted by the New Hampshire State Prison when the amount in the account exceeds

Wolff v. NH Department of Corrections Commission for \$250.00 has been paid. Failure to pay

the fee as ordered will result in dismissal of the action without prejudice. In all other respects plaintiff's request for <u>in</u>

<u>forma pauperis</u> has been granted.
